



A TIME TO PLANT

We are completing our second full year of fund raising for a new combined worship and children's ministry facility that will adjoin the current worship facility. During that time, we have been finalizing the layout, design, and audio/visual components of the new space and expect to bid the project in early 2018. In the meantime, our community continues to grow! The closest development to the church is Southglen, where new homes have just begun to reach completion with the first residents expected very soon. This neighborhood is planned to house 370 families! Even more, directly across I-10, Regent Park has completed its first few homes and is expected to have 950 new homes when completed. What was not on our radar last year when considering our immediate area growth is multi-family housing. Vantage at Boerne has apartments available now and will have 288 units when completed, and another 48 unit development is in the planning stages right here on Cascade Caverns Road. Boerne as a whole is on pace to have more than 600 annual new home starts for the 4th straight year, and BISD has more than 9,800 planned future lots. It is indeed a fantastic time to plant, as the Lord brings people to Boerne. May we be found faithful in "Exalting God, Engaging our Culture, and Enriching the Christ-Follower" now, and for many years to come.






