Week 1 Faith

This week we will be praying for faith for our children. We will be praying that they will:

- know and walk in the truth
- give their lives to Christ
- know they are loved
- live a life of love
- know, love and obey God's Word

Day One

Psalm 86: 11 *Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name.*

Teach _____ your way, Lord and give them a desire to know your truth

Day Two

Isaiah 12: 2 *Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and will not be afraid; for the Lord God is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation.*

Soften _____ heart to accept your gift of salvation and replace their fear with your peace that passes all understanding.

Day Three

John 15: 4. *Abide in me and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.*

Give _____ the desire to seek first your kingdom and abide in you

Day Four

John 15: 12 *My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you*

Jesus, give _____ the ability to live a life overflowing with your love.

Day Five

2 Timothy 3:16-17 *All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.*

Week 2 Character

Day One

Romans 12: 2 *Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is--his good, pleasing and perfect will.*

Day Three

John 3:16. *For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son; that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have life everlasting.*

Teach _____ to believe they are loved, have value and are enough

Day Four

Romans 7:4. *You also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to Him who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit for God.*

Grow your fruit in _____ so that the lost and hurting will see and be drawn to you through them.

Day Five

2 Timothy 4: 12 *Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.*

Equip _____ to be an example to others in all these areas so that their peers may see Jesus and be drawn to Him.

Week 3 Relationships

- form and maintain healthy relationships
- guard their hearts
- show respect and honor authority
- be discerning and seek wisdom in their decisions

Day One

Proverbs 13:20 *Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm.*

Lord guide _____ to walk with the wise. Bring friends that encourage them to grow in their love for you.

Day Two

Proverbs 4:23 *Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.*

Lord, guard _____ heart. Keep their eyes fixed on you so that in all they do they will pursue you. May they run to you daily.

Day Three

Proverbs 1:7. *The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction*

Teach _____ to fear your, Lord. May he/she grow a deeper love for you, Lord and not despise your instruction in their life.

Day Four

Colossians 3:1 *Since then you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.*

Lord, continue to remind _____ to set his/her heart on things above. Remind them whose they are.

Day Five

Proverbs 14: 27 *The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, turning a person from the snares of death.*

Day One

Day Two

Ephesians 5:1 *Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us...*

Day Three

Day Four

Proverbs 3: 3 *Let love and faithfulness never leave you: bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart.*

Day Five

Colossians 3: 15 *Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful*
