

# Currey Creek Upstream FAQ's

## **What do I wear?**

It's generally understood that clothing should be modest and respectful of the church setting. This means avoiding overly revealing clothing or anything that might be distracting. In essence, the goal is to dress in a way that shows reverence for the church and the occasion.

Here are some general guidelines based on common church practices:

*Modesty:*

Avoid clothing that is too revealing, such as low-cut tops, short shorts or skirts, or excessively tight clothing.

*Respectful:*

Choose clothing that is appropriate for a place of worship and that shows respect for the gathering.

## **What do I bring?**

We recommend bringing a Bible (Currey Creek uses the ESV translation but any Bible will work), journal and something to write with.

## **Is food served?**

Yes, we serve pizza from Papa Johns on a first come, first served basis. We do provide gluten free on first come basis as well.

## **What time?**
