

Read Job 1:6-12

1.	Who are the sons of God? (see Psalm 29:1; 89:6; Daniel 3:25)They are "sons" in the sense that they are beings that have come from God and are in some sense in His likeness. They function as servants to do God's will.
2.	Who came with them? ("Satan" means "opposes" or "resists")(By implication he is an angelic being, but not one of the sons of God)
3.	 Do we often think of Satan as the opposite of God? We should NOT! Satan is a created being whereas God is eternal and uncreated. The fact that Satan appeared before God demonstrates that Satan has access to God but he is subordinates to and in subjection to God.
4.	Why does God hold up Job as an example?
5.	If all have sinned, how is it that God declared Job blameless?
6.	Read Ephesians 3:10-11. How is this verse fulfilled by Job?
