6. What have you taken the initiative to do in your spiritual life?
7. Read Acts 16:6-10
 - a. What had Paul taken the initiative to do? (take the Gospel to the world)
 - b. Did Paul know where he was to go?
 - c. Did Paul know why he was supposed to go?App. Sometimes taking a step, any step consistent with God's agenda, leads us into the will of God.
