

2/7 - Small Group Questions

Week 22: Joy

- 1. Read Galatians 5:22: Why do we know that Christian joy is not natural?
- 2. Read Psalm 16: David asks for preservation, as if he were in a tough spot. Read Romans 5:3, I Thessalonians 1:6, and 2 Corinthians 8:2. Discuss how Christian joy can be experienced in the midst of suffering. For David to have taken refuge in God (v.1) is to give God the highest honor. Why?
- 3. How does fellowship with God's saints (v.3) contribute to either our joy or our angst? What is the determining factor?
- 4. In v.4 David says idolatry brings multiplied sorrow, why? Have you found this to be true in your own experience?
- 5. In v.5-6 David speaks of his inheritance. Do you feel the same about your inheritance? Why or why not? Have you contemplated your inheritance?
- 6. Is there a connection between the counsel of the Lord spoken of in verse 7 coupled with the priority given to the Lord in v.8 and the stability David experienced?
- 7. Verses 9-10 elaborate on this security. What two states of David's existence does he elaborate on?
- 8. Read Acts 2:22-36: In what way is verse 11 of Psalm 16 fulfilled in Peter's sermon?
