- 5. The synagogue was the local meeting house for Jews all over the world. Why did Jesus state they would be beaten there?
- 6. How does this prophecy fit in with the health and wealth gospel?
- 7. What was the sovereign purpose of these persecutions?
- 8. In vs.10, Jesus states the gospel must first be proclaimed. First before what?
- 9. Name at least three benefits of the Holy Spirit's presence when the disciples are on trial?
- 10. Why doesn't God deliver *from* the trial?
- 11. The gospel divides families, even to the point of giving over to death. We are also promised to be hated by all. Why?
- 12. How can one possibly endure to the end given all that has been predicted.
