1. What value does the Father place on Jesus and how does that inform our view of Jesus?
2. We are told that we are being built up as a spiritual house. Who is doing the building? What does this tell you about your value to the body? What does this tell you about your purpose for the body?
3. What are some of the spiritual sacrifices that we are to offer? Are you offering them?
4. How was Jesus a stone of stumbling for the Jews? Gentiles?
5. What does Peter mean when he teaches people are "destined to stumble"? Is this a troubling statement to you?
6. What is the purpose of our being a people of God's own possession? Are you fulfilling that purpose? If not, why not?

Someone read 2: 11, 12 aloud.

1. What value is there in abstaining from the passions of the flesh?
2. Why should we keep our conduct honorable?

LOOK FORWARD

1. What from this passage changes the way you see the upcoming week?
2. How can the group be praying for you this week?
