Opening Discussion:

Start the group by:

1. Going around and sharing when you first believed the Gospel.
2. What were the circumstances to bring you to belief?

Small Group Discussion Questions:

1. Read John 14:1-11 and read John 13:21;38. Jesus' words in 14:1 imply the disciples had a troubled heart. Why would they have been troubled?
2. Discuss how both uncertainty and discouragement weaken our faith.
3. Discuss how Jesus' teaching about his Father's house counter our weak faith. What promise does Jesus give in verse 3? Why is this important in context?
4. Jesus' answer to Thomas teaches us a couple of things:
 - a. Jesus claimed to be the ultimate answer. That answer was found not in a religious recipe, but in a relationship.
 - b. Jesus is the only means of reaching God as he is the only authorized revelation in human form.

How do these truths speak to the exclusive claims of Christianity?

5. Read 14:9,10. Respond to the following: "No material image or likeness can adequately depict God. Only a person can give knowledge of him since personality cannot be represented by an impersonal object."
