2. What 3 things are said about creation in v.20-22? (subjected to futility, will be liberated, groaning)
3. What is the Holy Spirit's role in our prayers?

Application Questions:

1. How are we to live knowing our present sufferings are temporal?
2. How are we to view creation in contrast to the way the world views it?
3. How does knowing God is working for our good affect the way we live?
