- 3. What is the Holy Spirit's role in our prayers?

## Application Questions:

- 1. How are we to live knowing our present sufferings are temporal?
- 2. How are we to view creation in contrast to the way the world views it?
- 3. How does knowing God is working for our good affect the way we live?
