Read Acts 2:22-41.

Ask: Does anyone remember the definition of the gospel that was shown last week?

The gospel is the announcement of the good news of Jesus's work to restore sinful image-bearers to the rightful worship of God.

- 1. What does Peter talk about in 2:22? (Jesus's ministry)
- 2. What does Peter talk about in 2:23? (Jesus's death)
- 3. What does Peter talk about in 2:24-32? (Jesus's resurrection)
- 4. What does Peter talk about in 2:33-36? (Jesus's exaltation)
- 5. What does Peter talk about in 2:37-39? (Salvation provided by Jesus)
- 6. What are the historical events Peter mentions in his message? (life, death, resurrection, and ascension)
- 7. What are the theological aspects of Jesus's life that Peter mentions? (Jesus's life, death, resurrection, and ascension all have saving significance. What are they?)
- 8. What is contemporary about Peter's message? (Jesus is living and reigning and ready to bestow salvation on those who call upon him!)
- 9. What was the external action asked for that demonstrated one had placed their faith in Jesus? Why is this action asked for by Peter? (See Jesus's instruction from last week!)
