Read Acts 2:22-41.

Ask: Does anyone remember the definition of the gospel that was shown last week?

*The gospel is the announcement of the good news of Jesus's work to restore sinful image-bearers to the rightful worship of God.*

1. What does Peter talk about in 2:22? (Jesus's ministry)
2. What does Peter talk about in 2:23? (Jesus's death)
3. What does Peter talk about in 2:24-32? (Jesus's resurrection)
4. What does Peter talk about in 2:33-36? (Jesus's exaltation)
5. What does Peter talk about in 2:37-39? (Salvation provided by Jesus)
6. What are the historical events Peter mentions in his message? (life, death, resurrection, and ascension)
7. What are the theological aspects of Jesus's life that Peter mentions? (Jesus's life, death, resurrection, and ascension all have saving significance. What are they?)
8. What is contemporary about Peter's message? (Jesus is living and reigning and ready to bestow salvation on those who call upon him!)
9. What was the external action asked for that demonstrated one had placed their faith in Jesus? Why is this action asked for by Peter? (See Jesus's instruction from last week!)
