

- 1. Read Genesis 25:19-28; 27:1-36
 - -What do we learn about Jacob from these passages?
- 2. Read Genesis 34:1-7, 13-17, 25-31
 - -Why didn't Jacob address the rape of his daughter?
 - -What is Jacob most concerned about after the actions of his sons?
- 3. Read Genesis 35:21
 - -What do you think Jacob should have done with Reuben?
 - -(To the men): Have you or are you passive in parenting or grandparenting?
 - -What can you do to address passivity?
 - -Pray and ask the Lord for wisdom, courage, and recognition. James 1:5-8
 - -Create an action plan. Proverbs 16:3, 9
 - -Ask your wife how you are progressing. Proverbs 18:1
 - -(To the women): How have you enabled passivity in your husband?
 - -What can you do to address the issue?
 - -Are you stepping in when you should wait? Proverbs 25:15
 - -Encourage your husband to lead, and then FOLLOW.
- 4. Read the following: Proverbs 14:30, 27:4; Song of Solomon 8:6
 - -What do we learn about jealousy from these verses?
- 5. Read the following: Psalms 37:1-3; James 3:14-16; Philippians 2:3
 - -What do we learn about combating jealousy?
