- 2. Why was Paul so aggressive in dealing with these false teachers? How would Paul be received today? Why?
- 3. In verse 12 Paul speaks to a cultural norm regarding the Cretans. What cultural norm would he use describing America? Boerne?
- 4. In verse 13 Paul instructs Titus to rebuke the false teachers. What is the purpose of this biblical discipline? Hint: It is in the verse itself. What seminal truth can we apply to parenting?
- 5. What "commands of people" are you tempted to follow? (v.14)
- 6. In an age in which grace is often violated, what can we learn from? (v.16) At what point do we evaluate a person's walk with the Lord?

May the Lord God teach his children truth by his Holy Spirit that they may walk in manner worthy of the Lord.
