- 1. As we consider the multitude (v.37) of people surrounding Jesus as he makes the short journey from Bethany to Jerusalem, identify the types of people (v. 37b, v.39) in the crowd and their probable expectations of Jesus' kingdom.
- 2. What is the significance of HOW Jesus "triumphally" entered Jerusalem? What does it teach us about what kind of king he is?
- 3. Most in the crowd were exuberant with Jesus' entry into the holy city. Contrast that with Jesus' mood. Also consider how Luke 19 ends. Why do you think the moods differed so much between Jesus and the crowd?
- 4. How do you think Christians today are guilty of "creating their own god", or having false expectations of Jesus' kingship? What is the relationship between this and the first two commandments in Exodus 20?
